TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

We are sorry to hear that, **Mr. GULAM NAVI AZAD., CMC No. AI45267, KISHUNPUR MOHAN, PURUSHOTTAMPUR, MUZAFFARPUR – 844127, BIHAR,** is suffering from chronic kidney disease – stage 4 and in need of renal transplantation. Transplant surgery is life-saving in patients with end stage kidney failure who, without treatment otherwise are likely to die of kidney failure. As you are aware at Christian Medical College, Vellore we undertake only related donor transplantation / deceased donor transplantation as defined in the Human Organ Transplantation Act 1995. All donors and recipients will have a HLA tissue match before being accepted into the programme. If there is any discrepancy in the HLA tissue match; additional tests will be done to prove the relationship followed by the authorization committee approval from Chennai as per Government norms.

The donors and recipients are initially screened by the Department of Nephrology and all cases are discussed weekly with the Department of Urology which does the renal transplant operation. There is a waiting period of 4 to 6 weeks before transplantation. Sometime we find that recipients are not fit or develop other medical problems which could delay the transplant operation. All donors will be thoroughly evaluated for medical/surgical illness before being accepted for transplantation.

It is also our policy that all transplant recipients must stay in Vellore for at least 4 months after transplant for follow up. This helps us to pick up early problems after transplantation. Donors may leave Vellore 5 weeks after operation and may resume all activity after 4 to 6 weeks. Kidney donors will need to come back for review after 3 months, 1 year and 5 years.


Other Expenses:

Cost of Vascular access creation, Hemodialysis, Erythropoietin and drugs for 8 weeks **Rs 1,00,000**

Given above are the estimation of dialysis and renal transplant surgery for a general patient in our institute which is an approximate figure; charges for the private patient will more than the estimated amount depending on the duration of stay. Charges will be levied as per actual services provided.

Please note that cost incurred due to any complication during dialysis (e.g. Infection), or cost for therapy for acute rejections are not included in the estimate.

After four months there will be an expenditure of approximately Rs. 15,000 – 25,000 per month for drugs and investigations approximately. Prescribed drugs should be continued lifelong. Please note this estimate can increase / decrease as the transplant outcome progress, when the patient comes on follow up.
